
## Overarching theme: Parents want consistency, predictability, and transparency.

64% indicated their child maintaining friendships was one of their biggest concerns 60% indicated the loss of the ability to participate in extra curriculars was one of their biggest concerns for their child

## Next steps to address these concerns:

- Technology: Provide on-line sessions and helpline for parents
- Mental Health/Wellness Committee included in District wide reentry planning
- Links to Mental Health resources: (district counseling staff and community contacts) with easy access
- Offer programming virtually on Mental Health and Suicide Safety
- Enhanced opportunities for students to socially interact with classmates/peers in both brick and remote learning environments this fall
- Clear flow charts of who to communicate with for different needs and how

- Communication vehicles to update parents on re-entry plans
- Survey families again to see if/how needs have change
