20/21 FIRST DAY CHECKLIST

2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR INFORMATION

The first day of school for all students in the North Syracuse Central School District is Thursday, September 10. Because things will look different this year, we have prepared this quick information sheet to help.



ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL: Each building has an individual plan for student drop-off and pick-up. All plans are listed [online by clicking here](#).



TEMPERATURE CHECKS: Students are required to have their temperatures checked before they enter District facilities each day. Parents/legal guardians are required to ensure that their child(ren) are not experiencing any [signs or symptoms of COVID-19](#) and do not have a temperature of 100.0 degrees or greater prior to them boarding their method of transportation to school.



REMOTE LEARNING/ONLINE EDUCATION: Students taking part in 100% Remote Learning have received their teacher assignments. All students taking part in remote and online learning on September 10 should [log into ClassLink by clicking here](#). If a student is having trouble logging in, call (315) 218-2108 to access their building's technical support.



TRANSPORTATION: Students are required to wear masks on school buses ([click here for exceptions](#)) and will be given a mask by the driver if they do not have one. Families are asked to [review school bus safety information](#) in advance. Parents should expect transportation delays for the first few weeks of school and should call the Bus Hotline at (315) 218-2035 with concerns.



HYBRID SCHEDULES: This year we are using a hybrid instructional model to limit daily attendance in accordance with [social distancing guidelines](#). All students should have received teacher placement letters, student schedules and transportation information. Students in grades 5-12 not attending in-person learning on the first day should [log into ClassLink by clicking here](#). If your student has not received a schedule or placement, contact his/her [building principal ASAP](#).



SCHOOL MEALS: In partnership with the United States Department of Agriculture, the North Syracuse Central School District is temporarily able to offer FREE breakfast and lunch meals to ALL students. This includes meals for students taking part in remote and hybrid learning. [Menus are listed online by clicking here](#). Meals are available for pick up from 4:30 to 5:45 p.m. every Monday through Friday when school is in session. Meals can be picked up at all secondary buildings.
