



Vote 2020

North Syracuse Central School District families and staff are encouraged to vote in next week's general election. Polling locations and times vary but will be open throughout the day on Tuesday, November 3. This year, New York State is providing [additional vote options allowing early voting or voting by absentee ballot](#) due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Because the **KWS Bear Road Elementary School and Cicero Elementary School buildings** are used as polling locations, students that normally attend in-person learning *in those buildings* will take place in remote instruction on Tuesday, November 3. The North Syracuse Central School District Jerome F. Melvin Administrative Office Building (5355 W. Taft Rd., N. Syracuse) is also used as a polling location. To ensure adequate parking is available for the large number of voters expected that day, all district office employees are being asked to park in the lot for North Syracuse Junior High School staff.


