The North Syracuse Central School District is located in the heart of Central New York, just outside the city of Syracuse. A short drive provides access to malls, hospitals and health care, four-season recreation, and many cultural opportunities. The area is also home to many institutions of higher education. The District serves the communities of North Syracuse, Clay, Cicero, Bridgeport, and Mattydale.

ACADEMICS & LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

The North Syracuse Central School District has a comprehensive instructional program from pre-kindergarten through high school provided in our eleven buildings. The Early Education Program offers an inclusive preschool program for three and four year-olds.

In each of our six elementary schools, instruction is centered around state standards in the four core areas of English/language arts, science, math and social studies.

Advanced technological learning experiences are available to middle and junior high students through computer coding clubs at both middle schools and an award-winning technical crew, 4D Productions at the junior high school.

Our programs at the high school level include advanced credit courses from eight colleges and universities, and 14 Advanced Placement (AP) courses. In addition, the high school offers a vast array of elective opportunities that will appeal to all student interests. This includes a full production studio and a sophomore through senior year leadership development program. Many support services are available to students through Academic Intervention, school resource officers, social workers and counseling services.

EXCELLENCE

The district's students and staff continue to excel, receiving local, state and national recognition. We are proud to announce Cicero-North Syracuse High School teacher Amy Hysick was selected as New York State Teacher of the Year for 2017. Hysick has been teaching in the North Syracuse Central School District for 12 years and is the first educator in the district to be selected for the prestigious recognition of New York State Teacher of the Year.

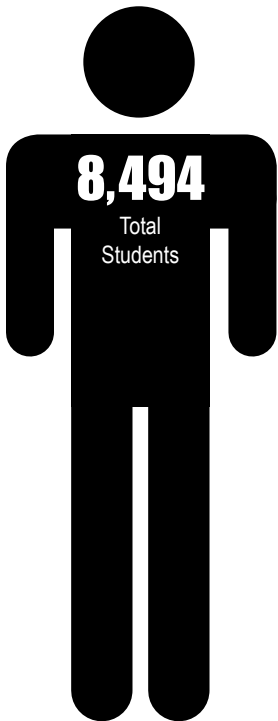
