## 2026-2027 School Calendar

### Provisions for School Closing

#### Due to Weather-Related Conditions or Other Emergency Situations

The following will apply relative to the 2026-2027 school year calendar to ensure that school closings for emergency situations do not cause the number of days in session to drop below the number required by law.

In the event that classes have to be cancelled for more than five (5) days, school will be in session for all PreK-12<sup>th</sup> grade students beginning with April 16, then April 15, April 14, April 13, and April 12, as needed. As a result, staff is cautioned not to commit themselves to any irrevocable plans for the spring recess in the event that any or all of these days will be required to make up for lost instructional days.

In the event that there are two (2) or more unused emergency closing days by April 15<sup>th</sup>, one (1) of those days shall be added to the Memorial Day Holiday. In the event that the allotted snow/emergency days are not used, PreK-7 days may be shortened accordingly on June 25 and 24 based on the number of snow days not used.
