North Syracuse Central School District Report Card

This special issue of the *District Dispatch* features the annual New York State Report Card results for the North Syracuse Central School District. The information provided in this newsletter is a summary of academic performance for students who took New York State Assessments in the 2015-2016 school year.

New York State Report Cards provide comprehensive data for all districts in the state, including enrollment, demographic, attendance, assessment, accountability, graduation rate and much more. The comprehensive state reports are available online from the New York State Education Department Report Card website at https://reportcards.nysed.gov.

State assessments are designed to help ensure that all students reach high learning standards. As required by the State, students that are not making appropriate progress toward the standards, must receive academic support.

Report Card review dates have been scheduled at each school. Parents and guardians are encouraged to participate in these very important discussions. School Report Card meetings will take place at each building on the dates and times listed in the box below.

North Syracuse Central School District Mission Statement

The students, residents and staff of the North Syracuse Central School District will work collaboratively to ensure a respectful and diversified learning environment. Our collective focus is to provide educational experiences and opportunities that inspire students to reach their individual potential as productive citizens.

School Accountability Status

Participation Standard refers to how many students took the State exams. The New York State Education Department requires that at least 95% of students participate in State testing.

Performance Index refers to the student's performance. The New York State Education Department uses a formula to calculate this number which includes how many students score at each level (1,2,3 or 4).

AMO or Annual Measurable Objective is a number set by the New York State Education Department that is a target for student performance.

Adequate Yearly Progress refers to whether or not a group has performed above the AMO. A school that meets or exceeds AMO is said to be in good standing.
