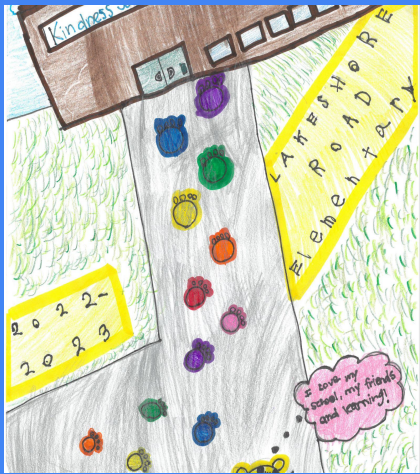
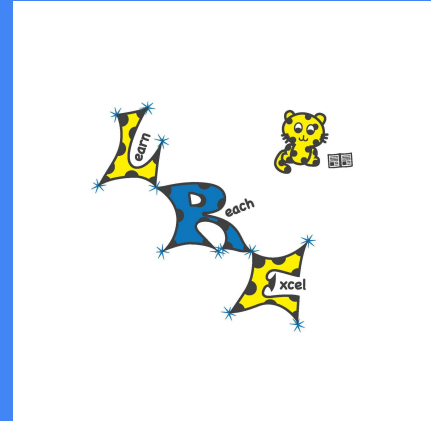

- If you have not phoned in your child's absence, please send a note into school when your child returns to school stating the reason for the absence.
- If your child is arriving late for school (past 9:15 am), you will need to sign him/her in at the Main Office. If you let the school know about an appointment in advance, you can avoid getting calls from the attendance system.
- When visiting or volunteering at the school, please sign in and out at the Main Office and get your visitor tag to wear during your visit.

Lessons are off to a great start! Students are doing a good job remembering their lesson day and time. Please find a quiet place in your house to have a lesson. It is important to set up your own “classroom” at home. And do the same when you are practicing your instrument.



PRACTICE is very important! Each week, students are expected to practice a minimum of 60 minutes a week. I suggest 15 minutes a day, for 4 days. Repetition is the key. November Nurse Updates



- ❁ Cold and Flu season is upon us. Talk with your child about covering their coughs and sneezes, avoiding touching their face/mouth and washing their hands frequently with soap and water.
- ❁ Illness: Students must remain home until they are free of fever (100°F), vomiting and diarrhea for 24 hours and are well enough to fully participate in class. If your child is requiring medication to control these symptoms, they may not attend school. Students diagnosed with Strep throat must be on antibiotics for 24 hours before return.
- ❁ Per NYS requirement, reminders will be sent home if your child's physical exam has not been received. 58 left to go!
- ❁ Hearing and vision screenings for students in 1st and 3rd grades are complete! A handful of students are scheduled for re-screens and you will receive a call regarding any concerns or referrals.
- ❁ With the weather changing, please send your student in clothing that is appropriate for the outdoors. This includes a coat, gloves, hat and boots.
- ❁ Please send spare clothing, including underwear, in your student's backpack, in the event they need to change.

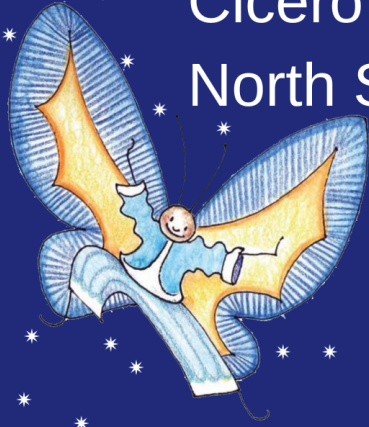

in honor of kids who HAVE to.

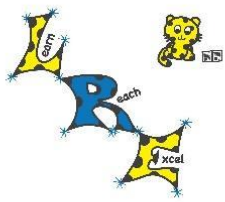
Paige's Butterfly Run Inc. fundraiser.
