


- The Main Office and Health Office are open from 8 am to 4 pm
- Children arrive between 9 am and 9:15 am. School begins at 9:15 am
- ALL CALL starts at 3:20 pm in the GYM so parking will be on the Rt. 11 side of the building to the right of the Church canopy, with buses loading at 3:20 pm
- PLEASE NOTIFY the school whenever your child is absent by calling the dedicated attendance line at 315-218-2615. The answering machine is on 24/7 for your convenience.
- If you have not phoned in your child's absence, please send a note into school when your child returns to school stating the reason for the absence.
- If your child is arriving late for school (past 9:15 am), you will need to sign him/her in at the Main Office. If you let the school know about an appointment in advance, you can avoid getting calls from the attendance system.
- When visiting or volunteering at the school, please sign in and out at the Main Office and get your visitor tag to wear during your visit.
- <u>NOTE TO PARENTS:</u> When you drop off or pick up your child(ren), PLEASE PARK IN THE BIG LOTS PARKING LOT CLOSEST TO ST. MARGARET'S MAIN DOOR.



Welcome Back!

We are adjusting to a new school as I am sure you are too! Your children have been amazing this week! Some things to keep in mind:

- Parent drop off is 9:00 9:15 and you can use the Route 11 lot in front of the building and can drop your child off at the gym door up front. Someone will be there. Pick up from 3:20 - 3:30 is also at the same lot and door.
- If you do plan to pick up, please call the office before 2:00, otherwise there is a good chance we will send your child on the bus.
- Our Phone number has not changed please call 315-218-2600 if you need to reach us.
- Please send your child with a water bottle each day.
- If you are picking up mid-day you will need to park in the Big Lots parking lot and use our main entrance - there is a button and key pad between the doors you will need to press, push the phone button, see below.

There have been questions regarding the playground and crosswalk. We do not share a playground with Roxboro Elementary, we have our own playground. Our playground is located behind what used to be the Rectory. No one lives in the building, but it is occupied by St. Margaret's Parish and Business Offices. There is a small side street that students cross with their teachers. We do not allow students to cross by themselves. Teachers have stop signs and high visibility safety vests they wear to the playground. We also do not cross if cars are visibly approaching.

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself to all of the parents of Lakeshore students attending our elementary school, currently located in St. Margaret's School in Mattydale. My name is Officer Sean Guerrina and I retired from the Onondaga County Sheriff's Office after working for 20 years. I began my career on the afternoon shift in Cicero, moved to the night shift in Mattydale/Lyncourt and eventually became a detective in the Abused Persons Unit. Prior to joining the Cicero PD family, I worked as an SRO at Reynolds Elementary in Baldwinsville for two years. I couldn't be happier to be working for the Cicero Police Department within the same district I spent the majority of my career.

I look at your children as my own and have nothing but safety in mind where they are concerned. Threats in regard to schools have become more common and I expect that trend to continue. Many parents are of the mindset that "children will be children" where threats are concerned since they know their child would never follow through with the actions threatened. Regardless, I ask all of you to have discussions with your children and let them know what are, and are not, appropriate comments. Understand that there will be consequences if threats are made within our school or while your children attend any schools within the North Syracuse School District (or any district now). Unfortunately, there are no idle threats where schools are concerned. We take them all seriously and investigate them as though they are legitimate. Repercussions will be the result and I don't want to see your children punished.

Thank you for your support and know that you can contact me with any questions (school related or otherwise). I will address any of your concerns and will find answers for you if I don't have them when we speak. Have a great day and I look forward to seeing all of you throughout the school year.

It sure is an exciting 2024-2025 school year! My goal is to support your child's health and well being, to facilitate their academic success. Here are a few highlights on how the Health Office operates and what you can expect for the school year.

Don't forget to stop by our office at St. Margaret's during Open House!!

- ★ To call your child in sick to school, contact Mrs. Nichols in Attendance at 315-218-2615. Notify the Main Office of plans for early dismissal.
- ★ Keep your contact information updated and always have a plan in place, in the event that your child needs to be picked up early. Pick up is recommended within 1/2 hour of contact from our office.
- ★ To keep all of our students safe and prevent the spread of infection, students must be free of vomiting, diarrhea and fever (100.4° F or higher) for 24 hours before returning to school, without the use of fever reducing medications. Additionally, 24 hours of antibiotics is required before returning from a bacterial illness, such as Strep throat or pneumonia.
- ★ Health History and Food Allergy forms have been sent home. Please complete and return both sides of the form. This does not replace a physical examination, but helps ensure safe care of your child at school. Please notify the Health Office of changes to your child's medical history, throughout the school year.
- ★ If your child has allergies, asthma, diabetes, or seizures, an action plan is required by their doctor, every school year.
- ★ Medication to be administered at school requires an updated doctor's order every school year. Medications must be delivered by an adult, in the original labeled package. Students are not permitted to self carry medications.
- ★ Parents may excuse a student from physical education once per school year with a written note. Further restrictions require a doctor's order.
- ★ NYS requires students in 1st and 3rd grades to have an updated physical exam by their provider. A physical dated September 4th, 2023 or later is acceptable. Students who do not submit a physical exam will receive a school physical with a district certified provider.
- ★ Health screenings will begin in early October for students in 1st and 3rd grades and students who are new to the district. Screenings consist of a hearing exam and a near/ distance/ color vision exam. A call home and referral letter will be initiated for students that require medical follow up.
- ★ It is highly recommended that students keep a change of clothing, including underwear, in their backpack.
