Dear North Syracuse Central School District Parents and Guardians:

This morning, the District was notified by the Onondaga County Health Department that a student at Roxboro Road Elementary School has tested positive for COVID-19. We were notified at 8:30 this morning and immediately began an investigation in conjunction with the County Health Department.

While confidentiality and privacy constraints prohibit the District from providing personal information about the student impacted, we can let you know that he/she was last in attendance on Thursday, September 24 and is currently quarantined by the County Health Department.

The District has identified students and staff thought to have been in close contact with the student and has provided that information to the County Health Department. All individuals suspected to have been in close contact have been quarantined outside of the building. The County Health Department is in the process of contacting any additional individuals. At this time, school will remain open.

Affected areas of the school have been sanitized and the District is taking additional precautions to protect the health and safety of its students and employees. We will continue to closely monitor this situation and communicate updates, if necessary.
