Dear North Syracuse Central School District Parents and Guardians:

The District has been notified by the Onondaga County Department of Health that a C-NS High School student has tested positive for COVID-19. As the County is currently in the process of performing contact tracing, the District will take a proactive measure by switching to remote learning at C-NS High School on Monday, October 26. If your child will need to be quarantined the Onondaga County Department of Health will be contacting you, which may take at least 24 hours. All other schools in the District will operate as normal following the set hybrid schedule.

While confidentiality and privacy constraints prohibit the District from providing personal information about the student impacted, we can let you know that the student was last in attendance on Tuesday, October 20 and is currently quarantined by the County Department of Health.
