Dear Cicero Elementary Faculty and Staff:

We have been notified that multiple individuals have tested positive for COVID-19 in a 4th grade class at Cicero Elementary School over the last 11 days.

We have identified staff and students thought to have been in close contact with the individuals and have provided that information to the County Department of Health. All individuals suspected to have been in close contact will be quarantined outside of the building. The County Department of Health is in the process of contacting any additional individuals.

Out of an abundance of caution and in consultation with the Onondaga County Department of Health, this fourth grade classroom impacted will shift to remote instruction through May 14 and return to in-person instruction May 17. All other classes, including other 4th grade sections, at Cicero Elementary will continue as scheduled. We will continue to closely monitor this situation and communicate updates, if necessary.
