Elementary Graduation Walk - Friday, June 6th at 9:15 AM - 11:00 AM

- 1. On <u>Friday, June 6th</u>, buses will leave the High School at approximately 9:15 AM to go to all six of our elementary schools. **Seniors who attended Cicero Elementary will walk over and back** that morning. **Students are NOT allowed to drive themselves**.
- 2. Seniors will have a chance to walk the halls of their elementary school <u>wearing their cap and gown</u> to show the younger students the importance of graduating high school. This is a great way for students to end their educational journey in the North Syracuse School District.
- 3. Seniors who did not attend elementary school in our District can participate and choose any elementary school to walk through.
- 4. If your child is interested in participating in this event, <u>please complete the attached parent permission form for the Elementary Graduation Walk</u>. Students must return the permission form to any of the House Offices by Thursday, May 22nd.
- 5. Any student not interested in this event will report to their scheduled classes.

The Senior Ball - Friday, May 30th at 7:00 PM - 11:00 PM

This year the Senior Ball will be held on <u>Friday</u>, <u>May 30th</u> at the <u>Marriott Syracuse Downtown from 7:00pm - 11:00pm</u>. <u>Please enter through the Warren Street entrance</u>.



- There will be a registration table where everyone must present a ticket.
 No one will be admitted without a ticket and tickets will not be sold at the door.
- 2. All students wishing to attend the Senior Ball must be in attendance for the half day on Friday, May 30^{th} .
- 3. The DJ will provide music for dancing from 7:00pm 10:45pm.
- 4. Whether you are dropped off or driving, <u>please use the Warren Street entrance into the Hotel</u>. If you are driving and need to park, parking is on your own. There are two parking garages close to the Marriott Syracuse Downtown. The Hotel recommends parking at the Harrison Street Garage.

<u>Directions to Hotel for Parking</u>: Follow Route 81 South to the Harrison Street Exit. Bear right onto Harrison Street, go past the Oncenter and on the left look for **Harrison Place**, there is a Garage there, along with a parking lot to park in.

- 5. Appropriate formal attire must be worn. Shoes must be worn. Jeans will not be allowed.
- 6. Proper manners and etiquette will be observed by all of those attending the Ball.
- 7. No smoking, drugs, alcohol or inappropriate behavior will be tolerated at the Ball. CNS Student Code of Conduct will be followed and those in violation will be required to leave the Ball. Violations may compromise your ability to participate in the graduation ceremony. Parents and the police may be contacted.
- 8. Any student on suspension will not be able to attend.
- 9. Once a student has left the Ball, he/she will not be allowed to return.

- Tickets may be purchased in Cafeteria 1 during all lunches at the Student Center.
- Tickets will be \$80.00 per person. Checks can be made out to the Class of 2025.
- Students bringing a date from another school must complete the attached "CNS High School Guest Permission Form" (or download a copy from the CNS website under Class of 2025).
 - This form must be completed and approved before purchasing a ticket.
- No form = no ticket!
- Guests must bring a photo ID to the Senior Ball.

The Senior Picnic - Monday, June 16 at 9:30 AM - 12:00 PM

- 1. The Senior Picnic will be held at Arrowhead Lodge, Monday, June 16 from 9:30 AM 12:00 PM.
- 2. Lunch and soda/water will be served. Activities and games will be provided as well as a DJ.
- 3. No coolers or backpacks are allowed at the picnic. Students may bring yearbooks.
- 4. The school dress code, smoking, drug, and alcohol policies will be in effect.
 Any violations of these policies may put your participation in graduation in jeopardy!
- 5. Students must take District provided transportation to the picnic; no student is allowed to drive. Any student that drives will not be permitted to enter this event.

Please complete the attached Parent Permission form for the Senior Picnic. Forms MUST be returned to any House Principal's Office by Thursday, May 22nd.

If students do not attend the picnic, they are expected to attend regular classes.


Mandatory Graduation Rehearsal - Friday, June 27 at 7:45am, CNS High School



NORTH SYRACUSE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR FIELD TRIPS (FORM F)

To be Completed by Student and Parent.

Rules:

- 1. Every student agrees to comply with the rules, regulations and any request of any chaperone.
- 2. Every student going on field trip agrees to a search of any and all personal effects by a same-gender North Syracuse Central School District employee at any time.
- 3. No one will purchase, consume or possess any alcoholic beverages or other controlled substances at any time during the trip.
- 4. If overnight, all students will be in their assigned rooms at a time set by the activity advisor chaperones.
- 5. If overnight, there will be bed checks each night, both announced and unannounced.
- 6. If overnight, should there be any damage to any room, those students assigned to that room will be financially liable.
- 7. The Board Policy 5311.1 Student Code of Conduct applies on all field trips (24 hours a day).
- 8. All rules of Public Safety Law apply.

Student's exclusion will occur if:

- 1. Student is deemed a safety or security risk
- 2. Student fails to return a signed permission slip prior to the field trip and/or
- 3. Other disciplinary action warrants exclusion.

Disciplinary Action:

Any student or group of students found consuming, or in possession of any alcoholic beverage, illegal drugs or unauthorized controlled substance, will be sent home as soon as transportation can be arranged and the parent(s)/guardian(s) notified. The cost of this transportation will be paid by the student and/or parent or guardian upon presentation of the receipt for such transportation.

Consequences for student discipline will fit the situation and be handled by the administration upon return.
