## ACADEMICS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

### COMMUNITY

The North Syracuse Central School District is located in the heart of Central New York, just outside the city of Syracuse. A short drive provides access to malls, hospitals and health care, four-season recreation, and many cultural opportunities. The area is also home to many institutions of higher education. The District serves the communities of North Syracuse, Clay, Cicero, Bridgeport, and Mattydale.

### ACADEMICS & LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

The North Syracuse Central School District has a comprehensive instructional program from pre-kindergarten through high school provided in our eleven buildings. The North Syracuse Early Education Program offers an inclusive preschool program for three and four year-olds.

In each of our six elementary schools, instruction is centered around state standards in the four core areas of English/language arts, science, math and social studies.

Advanced technological learning experiences are available to middle and junior high students. In addition to computer coding clubs at both middle schools and an award-winning technical crew, 4D Productions, at the junior high, the district has implemented a revised middle school schedule to give students additional opportunities to explore special classes in technology, family and consumer science, STEM, business and health.

Programs at the high school level include advanced credit courses from seven colleges and universities, 17 Advanced Placement (AP) courses and nine Syracuse University Project Advance (SUPA) courses. In addition, the high school offers a vast array of elective opportunities to appeal to all students. This includes a full production studio and a 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade leadership development program. Many support services are available to students through Liberty Resources, Academic Intervention, school resource officers, social workers, counseling services and a full-time Career Center.

### EXCELLENCE

The district's students and staff continue to excel, receiving local, state and national recognition. In June of 2019, Cicero-North Syracuse High School earned the distinction of being a New York State Education Department Recognition School for high academic achievement, growth and graduation rate.

Our Marching Band was honored to perform in the 2018 Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in New York City. During the 2018-2019 school year, our athletics teams received tremendous recognition with many teams earning league, sectional and even regional titles.

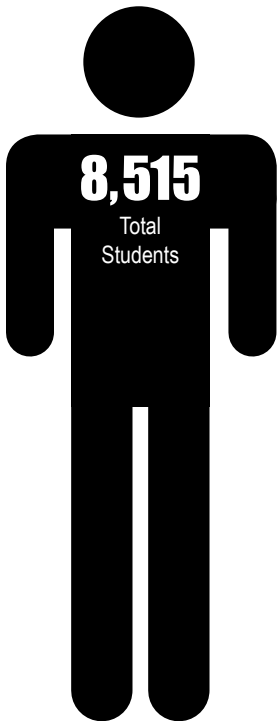
